The provisions of the proposed zoning changes to establish an East End Smart Growth Overlay District would apply to portions of the existing Office Park and Commercial Districts at the intersection of Route 110 and Elm Street/Clarks Road and a portion of the abutting R-20 residential district along Clarks Road as shown on the proposed Smart Growth District Map. The proposed Smart Growth District comprises of sub-districts.
