An Order to authorize the Mayor to accept and expend a Municipal Road Safety Program Grant awarded by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS) Office of Grants and Research (OGR)

Summary: This \$19,546 grant from EOPPS is awarded to the Amesbury Police Department to fund traffic enforcement campaigns, safety equipment, and non-enforcement activities by local police. All the initiatives contribute to reducing vehicle crashes and the resulting injuries and loss of life.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) provided this funding to the Commonwealth for distribution, through EOPSS; to 161 communities.

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

That the City of Amesbury authorizes the Mayor to accept and expend a Municipal Road Safety Program Grant awarded by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS) Office of Grants and Research (OGR) in the amount of \$19,546.
